Consultation on Admission Arrangements for 2027/28

Bishop Chadwick Catholic Education Trust is the Admission Authority for its academies. The Trust is consulting on the Admission Arrangements for 2027/28 for its Sunderland academies.

It is a mandatory requirement of the National School Admissions Code that all schools must have Admission Arrangements that clearly set out how children will be admitted, including the criteria that will be applied if there are more applications than places at an Academy. Where changes to admission arrangements are intended, all academies are required to consult before these are determined and published.

To align with Sunderland Local Authority, we are proposing the following amendment to the Tie Breaker:

 Distance is measured by a straight-line measurement from the centre of the home to the main entrance of the school, using a geographical information system (GIS). This uses Ordnance Survey maps and Land & Property Gazetteer (LLPG), which provides coordinates for every dwelling.

This will impact on the following schools:

- English Martyrs' Catholic Primary School, Sunderland
- St. Aidan's Catholic Academy, Sunderland
- St. Anthony's Girls' Catholic Academy, Sunderland
- St. Cuthbert's RC Primary School, Grindon
- St. John Bosco Catholic Primary School, Town End Farm
- St. Joseph's Catholic Primary School, Millfield
- St. Leonard's Catholic Primary School, Silksworth
- St. Mary's Catholic Primary School, Sunderland
- St. Patrick's Catholic Primary School, Ryhope
